About Monroe College

Transfer Credits

Students may receive full credit for all courses taken at the Police and Corrections Academies and are eligible for up to 12 credits for life experience. The College also grants credits for advanced training including homicide and sex crimes courses as well as basic, advanced, and command leadership courses. Students may also take CLEP exams to earn additional credit. Military training or credit earned at other institutions may also be awarded.

About the Grant

Monroe's Law Enforcement Grant is available to active, retired or disabled Uniformed Members of the Service (UMOS) police officers, as well as, correction and court officers. **This grant provides up to a 50% reduction of direct costs** based on a student's enrollment status. The grant may be used for qualified recipients who enroll either part-time or full-time in an Associate, Bachelor's, or Master's degree program at Monroe College.

Eligibility for Grant

Recipients must meet all of the undergraduate or graduate admissions requirements and be accepted to the College. To retain eligibility, students must maintain good academic standing and continuous enrollment.

* Up to 50% of direct costs based on each semester's enrollment status.
