Our 700+ full-time protectors are extensively trained in secure ground transportation, service excellence, emergency medical response, emergency aircraft evacuation, surveillance detection, managing inappropriate communications, threat assessment, and more. They all undergo videotaped propriety confidentiality training including a 50 year, 91 page confidentiality agreement.

Before clients ever arrive at a place, our protectors have made themselves intimately familiar with the location. A protector will arrive in advance to identify entrances/exits, public and non-public routes, local hospitals, restrooms, hotels, restaurants, etc. The advance protector anticipates challenges that might arise, mitigates challenges to safety and efficiency, and develops effective contingencies - before anything goes wrong. The preparatory work is memorialized in an Advance Report that is provided to key stakeholders.

Our protectors are equipped with backup communication systems and medical equipment, including first aid supplies and an AED. They check into hotels in advance, pre-screen and brief staff, coordinate with local law enforcement, security, and embassy services overseas.
